Requirements

- 4** Your fuel cache must be readily identified with a highly visible sign placed at the approved cache site. The sign must contain your company's name and approval number.
- Digital Government and Service NL requires you to maintain this log of fuel stored at your cache site. An up-to-date copy of the log should be available at your base camp location (if applicable) and your company's local office if you have one, or head office.**
- This record must be made available to officials of the Government Service Centre upon request. Failure to keep an accurate up-to-date log may result in the fuel cache approval being revoked.
