APPENDIX E
Terms and Conditions for Permit

Flood Zone Development

1. The proposed laydown area is located within the designated floodplain of Broad Cove River for the Town of Portugal Cove-St. Philip's. This development, and future development at the site, must comply with this Department's policy directive for Flood Plain Management W.R. 96-1.
2. Any further development in the flood zone area not specifically covered by this permit will require a separate permit from this Division under Section 48 of the Water Resources Act.
3. The proposed use of the facility and site will not involve any storage of pollutants such as fuels, chemicals, pesticides, etc.
4. The structure will not interfere with the flow of water or displace water such that it creates a worse flooding situation for other properties.
