Dear Diane Hollett and Anita Walsh:

RE: Waste Management Plan and Contingency Plan for the Portugal Cove – St. Philips Marine Ingredients Plan

On January 17, 2022, the Portugal Cove-St. Philips Marine Ingredients Plant Project was released from environment assessment, subject to conditions. The Pollution Prevention Division of my department required the development of two plans: a Waste Management Plan and a Contingency Plan.

As noted in my decision letter, Windy Heights Farm and 63562 Newfoundland and Labrador Ltd is to submit *"a Waste Management Plan that identifies how to manage all potential waste streams generated at the facility for the approval prior to commencement. The plan should be comprehensive and include details on odour and vector management during all stages of processing, including storage of preprocessed feedstock, process and wash water, and residual solids in the event that these waste streams cannot be fully utilized."*

You were also required to *"develop a contingency plan specific to the proposed undertaking to enable a quick and effective response to a spill event, including a spill of feedstock or a hazardous material, and to have spill response equipment readily available on-site."*

On April 21, 2022 you submitted a combined Waste Management Plan and Contingency Plan to the Pollution Prevention Division. The plan was reviewed by the Pollution Prevention Division and found to be acceptable, and is therefore approved.

Please be advised that you must abide by the commitments made in the Waste Management and Contingency Plan, and that any significant changes will be subject to additional review and approval.
