The Honourable Lisa Dempster, Minister of Environment and Climate Change, has announced the following relative to Environmental Assessment - Part 10 - of the **Environmental Protection Act**.

UNDERTAKINGS REGISTERED:

Garia River Crossing

(Reg. 2342)

Proponent: AuMEGA Metals Ltd.

The proponent is proposing to ford four stream locations, including one scheduled salmon river, Garia River, during a winter mineral exploration drilling program on its Bunker Hill Project area in south-western Newfoundland. Fording would be conducted to transport personnel daily and drilling equipment will be tracked in/out once only during frozen conditions. The undertaking was registered on December 20, 2024; the deadline for public comment is January 24, 2025, and the minister's decision is due by February 3, 2025.
