RE: Environmental Site Assessment – Condition of Release of the Southern Bay Blue Spruce R.V. Park and Campground

On July 7, 2021, the Southern Bay Blue Spruce R.V. Park and Campground project (the Project) was released from environmental assessment, subject to conditions. One of those conditions required an environmental site assessment (ESA) of the Project area completed by a registered site professional.

Please be advised that the ESA completed by a registered site professional has been received. The ESA was reviewed by the Pollution Prevention Division of my Department and was found to be acceptable. Upon consideration of the ESA, I find the following condition of release in my decision letter of July 7, 2021, to be fulfilled: *'The proposal is located within a 1.6 km buffer zone of a landfill. As such, the Pollution Prevention Division of my Department requires you to complete an environmental site assessment (ESA). The ESA should consider the potential for existing contamination of the site including soil, groundwater, surface water, and the potential for methane gas migration from the landfill. The ESA shall be performed by a registered site professional.'*

I encourage you to review the decision letter of July 7, 2021, and to take the necessary actions to fulfill the remaining conditions of release that are applicable throughout the Project's development and operation.
