A re-alignment of 20 Ha of harvesting with reference to the amendment application dated December 15, 2025 and Appendix D. This approval does not constitute an increase in harvest volumes in the Deep Bight River Protected Public Water Supply Area (servicing the Local Service District of Deep Bight). Note: The Department of Forestry and Agriculture is now referred to as the Department of Forestry, Agriculture and Lands.

All other terms and conditions of the original Permit will apply and failure to comply with the terms and conditions of this amendment and the original Permit will render this Permit null and void, place the Permit Holder and their agent(s) in violation of the *Water Resources Act* and make the Permit Holder responsible for taking any remedial measures as may be prescribed by this Department.


