### The original Water Use Licence dated APRIL 14, 2021 is amended as follows:

As per the email request dated March 1, 2024, the maximum estimated annual water withdrawal is increased from 10,000 cubic meters per year to 15,000 cubic meters per year, subject to water availability without changing the hydraulic characteristics of or causing impact on fish and fish habitat in the said body of water or impact on other water users in or outside the withdrawal and use activities area.

All other terms and conditions of the original Licence will apply and failure to comply with the terms and conditions of this amendment and the original Licence will render this Licence null and void, place the Licensee and their agent(s) in violation of the *Water Resources Act* and make the Licensee responsible for taking any remedial measures as may be prescribed by this Department.
