## **ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT BULLETIN**

Environment Minister Ralph Wiseman has announced the following events relative to the Environmental Assessment Act. In the case of documents received or approved, copies may be obtained by contacting the Department of Environment or by calling toll-free 1-800-563-6181. Comments on submitted documents are invited from the public, addressed in writing to the Minister, and are welcome prior to the deadline date shown.

### **1) UNDERTAKING REGISTERED:**

Shabogamo Lake Cottage Access Road  
Proponent: Mr. Gary Philpott

This undertaking is for the construction of a 2.4 km cottage access road at South East Arm in Shabogamo Lake near Labrador City. Construction is tentatively scheduled to start in July, 2001. This undertaking was registered on May 28, 2001, public comments are due July 03, 2001 and the Minister's decision is due on July 09, 2001.

### **2) UNDERTAKING WITHDRAWN:**

Forest Management District 18, Five Year Operating Plan (Amendment)  
Northern Half of the Great Northern Peninsula  
Proponent: Newfoundland Forest Service, Department of Forest Resources and Agrifoods

### **3) ENVIRONMENTAL PREVIEW REPORT REQUIRED:**

Avondale Automobile Drag Racing  
Proponent: Newfoundland Stock Car Association

The Minister has determined that there is insufficient detail to determine the significance of the environmental effects of the proposed undertaking and therefore has required the proponent to prepare an environmental preview report (EPR). The EPR must address outstanding deficiencies such as noise generation, sources and containment of pollution, and the traditional recreational use of the area. The minister shall appoint an environmental assessment committee for the purpose of advising him on scientific and technical matters

related to the undertaking.
