ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT BULLETIN

Environment and Conservation Minister Clyde Jackman has announced the following event relative to Part 10 Environmental Assessment of the Environmental Protection Act.

UNDERTAKING REGISTERED:

Frederickton Mink Farm

Proponent: Mr. Terry Wheaton

(Reg. 1334)

The proponent plans to establish a 1,500 breeder mink five kilometers south of Frederickton, Notre Dame Bay (each female breeder has one litter of 4-5 kits on average per year). The land is located adjacent to Beaver Hill at a former quarry site off Route 332. Construction will include three 9 metre by 43 metre breeder sheds, a 6 metre by 9 metre storage shed, a 15 metre by 12 metre manure pad and small electrical shed.

The undertaking was registered on May 28, 2007; public comments are due by July 2, 2007; and the Minister's decision is due by July 12, 2007.
