The Honourable Charlene Johnson, Minister of Environment and Conservation, has announced the following event relative to Part 10 Environmental Assessment of the Environmental Protection Act.

#### **UNDERTAKING REGISTERED:**

##### **Labrador Straits Hiking Trail and Interpretation Areas**

**Proponent: Labrador Straits Historical Development Corp.**

(Reg. 1392)

The proponent is to develop a linked network of tourism amenities. The network will be known as the Labrador Pioneer Footpath and will consist of highway pull-offs, interpreted rest areas, wilderness trails linking communities, signage and marketing materials. The interpreted trail system will travel approximately 75 kilometres from L'Anse au Clair to Red Bay.

The undertaking was registered on July 29, 2008; public comments are due by September 3, 2008; and, the minister's decision is due by September 12, 2008.
