The proponent has submitted the following five Component Studies as part of the ongoing environmental assessment for the Project:

- 1) Vegetation Component Study
- 2) Freshwater Environment: Fish and Fish Habitat and Water Resources Component Study
- 3) Historic and Heritage Resources Component Study
- 4) Socioeconomic Environment: Communities, Land and Resource Use, Tourism and Recreation Component Study
- 5) Socioeconomic Environment: Marine Fisheries in the Strait of Belle Isle Component Study.
