The Undertaking:

The proponents plan to develop a 2 kilometre Snowmobile Trail in the Humber Village area of Western Newfoundland. The trail is intended to provide a safe access ,out of the Village, to the groomed trail system managed by The Newfoundland And Labrador Snowmobile Federation. It will commence/exit the Village from Pine Street and travel westward on the former COTC cable line to the “Butler Property” for an approximate 420 meters. It will then turn northward on a right-of-way between the “Butler and Sharpe” property and on to the back country for a further distance of approximately 1.5 kilometres. The proposed trail will then connect with a network of forest access roads(formerly used by Corner Brook Pulp and Paper in their winter wood harvesting operations) which subsequently leads to the noted Federation managed groomed trail in the Hughes Brook area.
