Raptor Nest: No forestry activity is to occur within **800 meters** of a bald eagle or osprey nest during the nesting season (Mar 15 to July 31) and **200 meters** during the remainder of the year.

Protected Public Water Supply Areas: Within protected water supplies, there will be no cutting within **150 meters** of the intake pond or stream and no cutting within **75 meters** of the main river channel. There will be no cutting within **50 meters** of all ponds and streams flowing into the intake pond or stream.

Sensitive Wildlife Areas: No Cutting within Bonavista Stewardship Management Unit- Area has been excluded from CC02528 AND CC02568.

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
