RE: Round Pond Quarry Project

On May 9, 2017, you were advised by the Minister of Environment, Climate Change and Municipalities that your project was released from further environmental assessment subject to a number of conditions.

Section 17 (1) of the Environmental Assessment Regulations, 2003, under the Environmental Protection Act states that the minister's determination remains in force for three (3) years after the minister has advised the proponent, and after the expiration of the three (3) year period that determination shall be considered to be void and the undertaking must be registered again.

More than three (3) years have elapsed since you were notified of the minister's determination. Please be advised that the minister's determination is now considered void and the undertaking must be registered again with environmental assessment, if you wish to proceed with the project.
