Regulatory and Technical Advice from Government Departments/Divisions

Fisheries, Forestry and Agriculture Department, GNL (the Proponent)

1 Climate Change Branch (CCB), Department of Environment and Climate Change (ECC)

- 1.1 Proponent is advised of the impact of forest management practices on climate change and the requirement for five-year forest management plans to explicitly detail mitigation measures.
- 1.2 Proponent is advised to operate heavy equipment in a manner that maximizes fuel efficiency, thereby reducing greenhouse gas emissions that could contribute to climate change. For further information, please contact the CCB at (709) 729-1485.

2 Pollution Prevention Division (PPD), ECC

- 2.1 Proponent is advised to have spill response equipment readily available on-site to enable a quick and effective response to a spill event. Any spill or leak of gasoline or associated product is to be reported immediately to the Environmental Emergencies Telephone line at 1-800-563-9089. 3 Water Resources Management Division (WRMD), ECC

- 3.1 Proponent is advised to obtain a permit under Section 48 of the **Water Resources Act** for any work in or within fifteen (15) metres of a body of water prior to the start of the work.
- 3.2 Proponent is advised any effluent or runoff leaving the site will be required to conform to the requirements of the Environmental Control Water and Sewage Regulations. For further information, please contact the WRMD at (709) 729-2563.

4 Government Service Centre (GSC), Department of Digital Government and Service NL (DGSNL)

- 4.1 Proponent is advised an electrical permit is required prior to the commencement of any electrical work.
- 4.2 Proponent is advised should the Project require a subsurface sewage disposal system, prior approval is required from DGSNL.
- 4.3 Proponent is advised to make application to DGSNL for Fire/Life Safety and Building Accessibility review/approvals.
- 4.4 Proponent is advised a permit is required for the construction of an access road in a protected area, or for any access onto a protected road.

- 4.5 Proponent is advised to make application to DGSNL for Fire/Life Safety and Building Accessibility review/approvals.
- 4.6 Proponent is advised any existing tree screen concealing the operation from the public view is to be maintained, and a tree screen of 30 metres is to be maintained between the highway right-of-way and Project site. For further information, please contact (709) 729-0248.

5 Occupational Health and Safety (OHS), DGSNL

- 5.1 Proponent is advised to ensure that activities are conducted in compliance with the **Occupational Health and Safety Act** and related regulations. This includes the responsibility for ensuring that contractors hired to perform work also comply with the legislation. For further information, contact OHS at (709) 729-7454.

6 Department of Transportation and Infrastructure (TI)

- 6.1 Proponent is advised that there shall be no encroachment on property or highways owned by the TI without express written consent from the Deputy Minister. The Proponent shall be fully responsible to identify property and highways owned by TI. For further information, please contact (709) 729-7713.

7 Environment and Climate Change Canada (ECCC)

- 7.1 ECCC recommends that the Proponent developing the following plans:
 - An oil spill prevention and response plan.
 - A contingency plan that considers potential accidents and malfunctions that take into account site-specific conditions and sensitivities.
 - A wildlife emergency response plan.
- 7.2 ECCC advises that in order to avoid nest destruction and to accommodate the breeding season of migratory birds, operations should consider nesting locations between mid-April and Mid-August in this region. ECCC requests that species-at-risk sighting be reported to the Canadian Wildlife Service (CWS) at <http://www.accdc.com/en/contribute.html>. For further information, please contact (709) 772-4313.
