The Honourable Dr. Scott Reid, Minister of Environment and Climate Change, has announced the following relative to Environmental Assessment - Part 10 - of the **Environmental Protection Act**.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT ACCEPTED:

Indian Head Hatchery Expansion Project

(Reg. 1975)

Proponent: Mowi Canada East Inc.

A review has been completed of the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) submitted on June 4, 2025. On August 13, 2025, the minister determined that the EIS complies with Part 10 of the **Environmental Protection Act** and the EIS guidelines.
