RE: Northeast Arm Former US Recreation Camp Demolition (the Project) Bat Survey

On August 20, 2025, the Project was released from environmental assessment, subject to conditions. One of the conditions required Public Services and Procurement Canada to submit a Bat Survey prior to commencing any work related to the Project.

On September 12, 2025, Public Services and Procurement Canada submitted a Bat Survey to the Department of Fisheries, Forestry, and Agriculture – Wildlife Division. I am advising you that this plan has been reviewed and accepted.

You must abide by all commitments made in the Bat Survey and in all environmental assessment submissions. You must also comply with all terms and conditions of the August 20, 2025, decision letter. Any significant change to the Bat Survey or to the Project must be submitted to this department prior to construction, to be reviewed for regulatory requirements including environmental assessment.
