Figure1. District Profile, 2016-17: Number of Schools, Pupils, and Teachers by School District

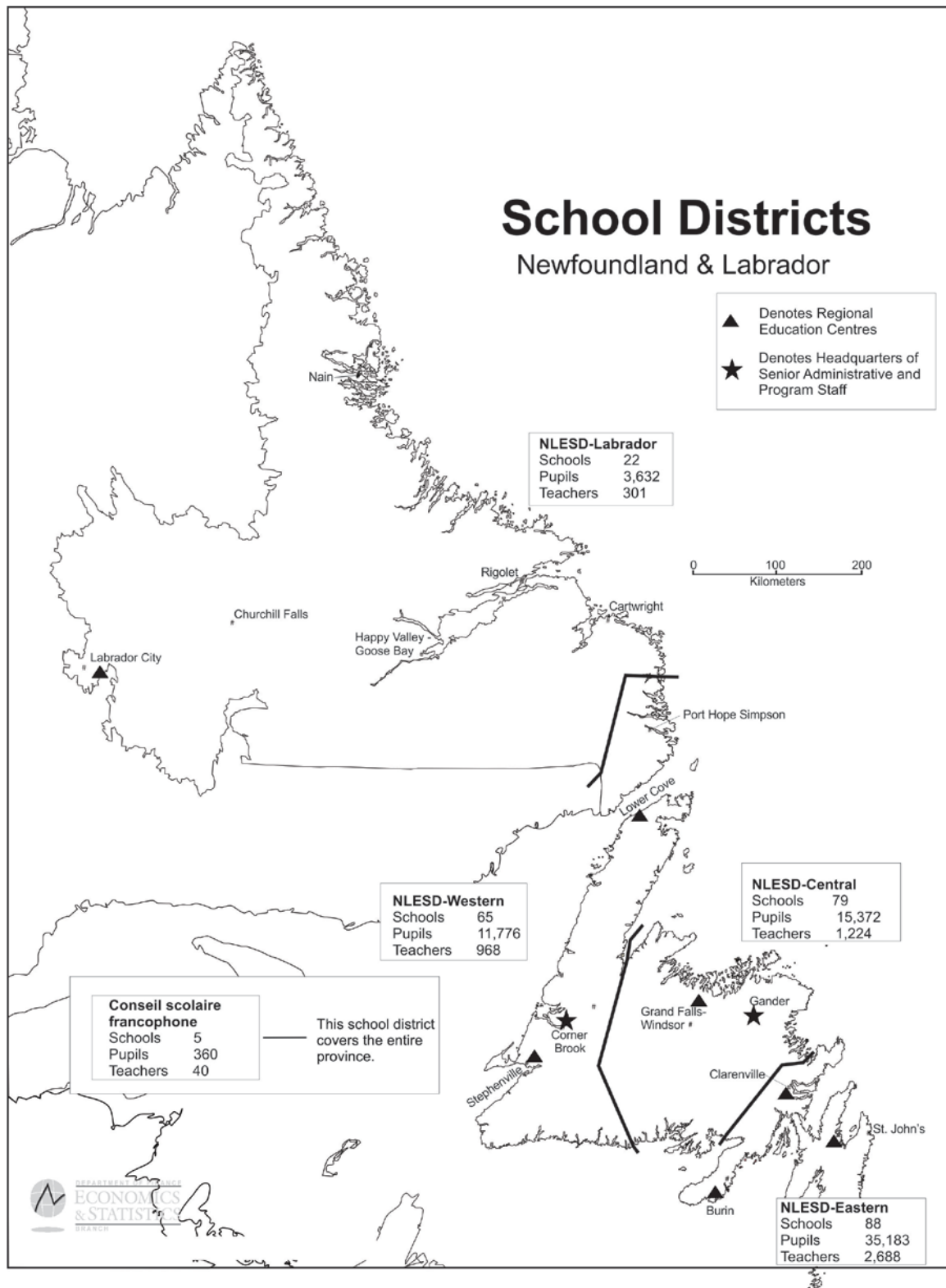
