NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR CORPORATION LIMITED

In southwestern Labrador Wabush Mines, Pickands Mather and Company, Managing Agents, continued its programme of major plant and town-site construction. In well advanced stages of erection by year's end were plant buildings to house the crusher, main conveyor tunnel, ore storage, mill and maintenance shops. At the adjacent mine site 1,200,000 cubic yards of over-burden were stripped and 23,500 feet of development drilling completed. At the townsite 1,200 workmen have been provided with permanent accommodation in the form of bunkhouses plus 162 family units. A staff building, cafeteria and school were also completed during the year. A total of 450 housing units will be occupied by 1965 when the project commences production of six million tons of concentrates per year.

During 1962 development work was commenced by the Canadian Javelin subsidiary, Julian Iron, on the Julianne Lake ore body subleased from NALCO. An access road was completed and a 2,200-foot cross section of the ore zone was stripped, mapped and sampled during the year. A separate plant and townsite is planned for this operation which may produce a variety of iron ore products.
