Prospectors and Others Supported by the Matty Mitchell Prospectors Resource Room in 2019

In 2019, the MMR provided mentoring, technical support and promotional assistance to more than 145 individual prospectors, from all parts of Newfoundland and Labrador who made more than 824 requests either through personal visits, email enquiries or telephone calls (Appendix 1). These services are freely provided to clients. Many visitors browsed our sample collection housed in the Resource Room and the Matty Mitchell Sample Library. Information services were also provided, gratis, to the public and to representatives of local and national exploration companies.

The MMR helped prospectors with sample and mineral identification, data interpretation and presentation, selection and refinement of target areas, generation and further advancement of new prospects, and re-interpretation of existing prospects. We help prospectors compile information packages, which are then circulated at mining and exploration conferences in Vancouver (Roundup), Toronto (PDAC) and St. John's (Mineral Resources Review). These information packages are distributed by the MMR and the prospectors to interested companies, as follow-up throughout the year. These efforts helped prospectors attract new mineral exploration to the Province in 2019.

The MMR also had several visitors from out-of-province who were interested in geo-tourism or in casual prospecting and rock-hounding. Appendix 1 lists individuals who were directly assisted during this time; many visited or requested assistance on multiple occasions.

Junior exploration companies active in the province were assisted in a more indirect way through the MMR promotional activities across Canada during 2019. For example,

PROSPECTOR SUPPORT: MINERAL INDUSTRY TRADE SHOWS AND CONFERENCES

In 2019, the MMR continued its major role of providing logistical and promotional support for prospectors attending local and national, mineral exploration and mining conferences and trade shows. Assistance was provided to prospectors prior to, during and following the events. The MMR also, where possible, assists those who cannot attend by promoting their properties at these meetings.

The MMR provided promotional material for the following 2019 industry meeting:

The Resource Room worked in conjunction with Mining Industry NL and the Geological Survey and Mineral Development divisions of the Mines Branch at these meetings, focusing on individual prospect promotion and promotion of the province in general as a region to invest in mineral exploration and development. In the Toronto and Vancouver meetings, the MMR availed of space provided by Mining Industry NL to display Property Posters described below.

Roundup Conference, January, 2019

PDAC Conference, March, 2019

A group of 8 prospectors (listed below with some of their properties and main commodities) were funded jointly by Mining Industry NL and the Department of Natural Resources to attend the PDAC event in Toronto. Some NL prospectors also availed of rental booth space in the Prospectors Tent. The latter is situated adjacent to the Trade Show booths and affords an excellent opportunity to meet industry representatives. A number of other prospectors from the province (self-funded) also attended. With a registration of over 25,000 people (in 2019) from every mining corner of the world, the PDAC provides an excellent venue for prospectors from Newfoundland and Labrador to meet face-to-face and network with professionals from the mining industry, potential optionors of prospectors' properties.



St. John's, November, 2019

Mineral Resources Review is Eastern Canada's largest mineral industry conference and trade show, attended by about 750 delegates (in 2019), trade show exhibitors and visitors. The event showcases all aspects of the mineral exploration and mining industry in Newfoundland and Labrador. More than 20 prospectors from the province had booth space at the trade show; the MMR geologist prepared posters and had rock samples cut and polished for these prospectors to promote their properties.

Prospectors Option Agreements 2019

In 2019, at least 6 prospectors (either as individuals or in partnerships) from Newfoundland and Labrador optioned rights to at least 9 properties in at least 7 deals; the majority of the properties are on the island. At least one of the companies involved is new to the province. Some of the critical contacts, which resulted in successful option agreements, are typically made at meetings such as Roundup and PDAC. Prospectors play a major role in attracting companies to the province; companies, which, in some cases, have never worked here before. In some instances, prospectors are the first point of contact between these new companies and the Newfoundland and Labrador business community. There was also at least one joint

venture deal done between a junior exploration company working in West Central NL and a company new to the island.

Property Poster Series



PARTICIPATION IN PROSPECTOR TRAINING COURSES

St. John's, 6th November, 2019

The Annual Pre-Conference, one-day prospectors' course was held immediately prior to Mineral Resources Review 2019. This year's presentations were on "Myriad 2: The New Online Map Staking System" by Justin Lake of DNR and "Updates to the Geoscience Atlas" by Pauline Honarvar also of DNR. The presentations had excellent attendance by 30 prospectors. The MMR geologist helped to organize this one-day event.

PUBLIC AWARENESS INITIATIVES and OUTREACH ACTIVITIES

The MMR geologist attended the Newfoundland and Labrador Prospectors Association (NLPA) AGM on May 4th in Mt. Pearl. Attendees benefited from a display of rocks and reading material from the MMR.

In June, 2019, the NLPA held an evening seminar for local prospectors in Clarenville. The MMR geologist attended and provided a rock and reading material display.

In December, 2019, the MMR geologist gave a presentation on Updates to the Geoscience Atlas to a group of prospectors in Stephenville; the meeting was organized by the NLPA. A rock display and geological resources material were also provided.

Following Stephenville, the MMR geologist gave a presentation on the Resource Room to several students and the facilitator, Peter Frampton, at the Grand Falls/Windsor College of the North Atlantic. The students were attending the new one-year Geological Technician certificate program initiated by the College.

As in past years, the MMR participated in initiatives to help promote prospecting and the possibilities of new economic development linked to the minerals industry. The MMR once again collaborated with Mining Industry NL and the Geological Survey in displaying prospecting information at the Baie Verte Mining Conference and the Expo Labrador Conference.

SAMPLE LIBRARY AND OTHER RESOURCES

New rock samples from across the province were added to the collection in 2019. Dave Evans and Baxter Kean are thanked for donating books and rocks to the room. Prospectors are encouraged to come and browse through our selection of rocks and minerals and take pictures of the samples to help with identification of rocks in the field.

Soil augers, lake sediment samplers and gold pans are available for loan-out from the resource room.
