



## Public Sector Compensation Transparency Act Report

This form is used to report information required by section 3 of the Public Sector Compensation Transparency Act:

3. Before July 1 of each year the minister shall disclose the following information with respect to each employee of government whose total compensation during the previous year was greater than the threshold:

- a) the name of the employee;
- b) the title of the position the employee held on December 31 of the previous year, or where the employee discontinue employment with government during the year, the title of the position the employee held at the time he or she discontinued employment;
- c) the area in government in which the employee was employed on December 31 of the previous year, or, where the employee discontinued employment with government during the year, the area in government in which the employee was employed at the time he or she discontinued employment; and
- d) the amount of total compensation paid to the employee.

To the best of my knowledge and belief, the attached is the listing of the employees of the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador who received total compensation of more than \$100,000 in 2023, reported in accordance with the Act and Regulations.
