

Fish Processing Licensing Board Meeting

September 14, 2021

Board Recommendation

Dear Minister Bragg:

The Fish Processing Licensing Board (Board), held a conference call on September 14, 2021. The Board considered one application that was comprised of the following:

- Transfer of an in-province retail fish establishment licence and a primary processing licence from Ship Harbour to Argentia for Dandy Dan's Fish Market Limited.

The Board is making the following recommendation:

1. Dandy Dan's Fish Market Limited, Ship Harbour, has two fish processing licences. A primary processing licence for groundfish (all species), pelagics (all species), snow crab, crab (other), lobster, lumpfish, and seal, and an in-province retail fish establishment licence. There were no letters of objection or support received. It is the Board's view that the move from Ship Harbour to Argentia will have no impact on regional balance and after careful consideration, it has been concluded that there are no other mitigating circumstances that would not warrant granting these transfers.

The Board recommends **approving** the transfer of the primary processing licence and in-province retail fish establishment licence from Ship Harbour to Argentia for Dandy Dan's Fish Market Limited.
