Food - Annual Inspection Jan 23, 2026	Non-Critical Item(s)	506 - Equipment in good repair, cleaned and sanitized	Second hand sink to be put in good working order, along with supplied dispensers, recommend different style of hands free sink or one with large taps. Work order submitted. Handsink by entrance to provide a mix of warm water and plumbing fixtures/fittings are to be installed so they are easily cleaned. Ensure all mechanical ventilation is professionally cleaned and dated certificate is provided. Remove all rubber/ vinyl strips dangling from joins in hoods as well as removing plastic strips/ pieces.
		702 - Non-food contact surfaces properly constructed, in good repair and clean	Damaged flooring to be repaired or replaced. Provide an action plan with proposed completion dates.
		704 - Adequate protection from vermin and insect pests	Ensure cleaning of drains is continued, excess moisture is removed in drain areas and continue pest control to reduce fruit fly issue.
