**16.2** A carbon product used in a source category prescribed in paragraphs 5(1)(a), (c), (d) and (e) of the *Management of Greenhouse Gas Reporting Regulations* by an industrial facility that has a greenhouse gas reduction target under section 5 of the *Management of*

*Greenhouse Gas Act* in the year in which the carbon product was purchased is exempt from the tax imposed under subsection 72.1(1) of the Act.
