



1. Schedule A of the *Endangered Species List Regulations* is amended by adding immediately after the species "Griscom's Arnica – *Arnica griscomii* subsp. *griscomii*" the species "Gypsy Cuckoo Bumble Bee – *Bombus bohemicus*".

2. Schedule B of the regulations is amended by

- (a) adding immediately after the species "American Marten (Island of Newfoundland Population) – *Martes americana atrata*" the species "Black Ash – *Fraxinus nigra*";**
- (b) adding immediately after the species "Common Nighthawk – *Chordeiles minor*" the species "Hudsonian Godwit – *Limosa haemastica*";**
- (c) adding immediately after the species "Sharpleaf Aster – *Oclemena acuminata*" the species "Suckley's Cuckoo Bumble Bee – *Bombus suckleyi*"; and**

7.1 (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of these regulations, multi-employer pension plans shall be exempt from the following:

- (a) paragraph 12(3)(d);
- (b) subsection 12(4);

(2) Notwithstanding paragraph 12(3)(c), the maximum period for liquidating a going concern unfunded liability for a multi-employer pension plan is within 10 years of the review date.


2. Section 15 of the regulations is amended by adding immediately after subsection (12) the following:

(13) Subsections (1) to (9) do not apply to a multi-employer pension plan and the transfer value of a pension benefit from a multi-employer pension plan shall be equal to the commuted value.
