NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR REGULATION 46/24

Fire Ban Proclamation
under the
Forestry Act

(Filed July 20, 2024)

Under the authority of section 99 of the *Forestry Act*, I proclaim a fire ban for all areas of Labrador.

PROCLAMATION

The setting of fires on forest land or within 300 metres of forest land is prohibited in all areas of Labrador except under the following conditions when the fire weather index is not very high or extreme:

1. The fire is set in an outdoor wood burning unit that
 - (a) is made entirely of non-combustible materials;

- (b) completely contains the fire;
 - (c) is screened to prevent the escape of sparks or other burning material;
 - (d) rests on legs or supports and is placed on mineral soil or non-combustible material having a surface area of not less than 1.5 square metres; and
 - (e) is located not less than 3.5 metres from the nearest woods, brush or other flammable material.
2. The fire is set in an incinerator unit
- (a) that
 - (i) completely contains the fire,
 - (ii) is screened to prevent the escape of sparks or other burning material,
 - (iii) is located on private property and not less than 15 metres from the nearest woods, brush or other flammable material, and
 - (iv) is in good working order and an attendant is on site where the fire weather index is high; and
 - (b) all incinerator ash is totally extinguished before being discarded on mineral soil not less than 15 metres from the nearest woods, brush or other flammable material.

The fire ban does not apply to the following:

- 1. A fire set in an indoor wood stove provided the chimney or stove pipe is screened to prevent the escape of sparks or other burning material.
- 2. A fire set using a gas, kerosene, alcohol, propane or charcoal burning unit provided that
 - (a) the unit is not used within 3.5 metres of any woods, brush or other flammable material; and

(b) all coals from a charcoal burning unit are totally extinguished before being discarded and are not discarded in any manner which may start a fire.

3. A fire set using a match or cigarette lighter for the purpose of lighting a cigarette, cigar or pipe provided that the person lighting or smoking the cigarette, cigar or pipe is not in motion.

The ban shall continue in force until July 29, 2024.

Fire Ban Proclamation, Newfoundland and Labrador Regulation 45/24 is repealed.

Short title **1.** This order may be cited as the *Wind Hydrogen Hub Land Reserve Order*.

Definitions **2.** In this Order

(a) "Act" means the *Lands Act*;

(b) "available Crown lands" means Crown lands that have not been

(i) granted, leased or the subject of a licence or easement, or

(ii) otherwise lawfully set apart or alienated from the Crown; and

(c) "Wind Hydrogen Hub Land Reserve" means Crown land reserved under section 3.

Purpose **3.** The Wind Hydrogen Hub Land Reserve is established to ensure that available Crown lands located within the area described in the Schedule are available for the purpose of establishing a wind hydrogen hub project.

Term **4.** The Wind Hydrogen Hub Land Reserve is established until January 23, 2026.

Exception **5.** Notwithstanding section 3,

(a) the minister may accept applications for Crown lands included in the Wind Hydrogen Hub Land Reserve where the application states that

(i) the Crown lands are required

(A) on an urgent basis for the public good,

- (B) for meteorological towers and associated developments or infrastructure, or
- (C) for access or utility purposes for developments existing on or before July 23, 2024, or
- (ii) the person making the application has acquired an interest in the Crown lands under section 36 of the Act; and
- (b) the minister may issue grants, leases, licences or easements in relation to Crown lands included in the Wind Hydrogen Hub Land Reserve where
 - (i) the minister is satisfied that the Crown lands are required for a purpose referred to in subparagraph (a)(i),
 - (ii) the minister is satisfied that the person who made the application has acquired an interest in the Crown lands under section 36 of the Act, or
 - (iii) the application for Crown lands was received on or before July 23, 2024.
