CITY OF CORNER BROOK ACT, 1990



RECREATIONAL VEHICLE REGULATIONS

PURSUANT to the powers vested in it under Section 201 and 202 of the *City of Corner Brook Act*, R.S.N.L. 1990, c. C-15, as amended, and Section 15 of the Off-Road Vehicles Act, R.S.N.L. 2021, c 0-5.1 as amended, and all other powers it enabling, at a session convened on May 12, 2025 the CORNER BROOK CITY COUNCIL repealed the current Recreational Vehicles Regulation 2022 and replaces it with the Recreational Vehicles Regulation. The new regulation included an amended schedule A that will connect the current designated route of Petries Street to Pikes Avenue and Connor's Road to Bartletts Avenue, enabling access to the Bay of Islands Yacht Club.






