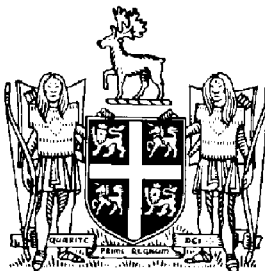

IN GENERAL TERMS, DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT NO. 17, 2025 will amend:

1. Schedule A (Definitions) to distinguish between secondary suite (currently subsidiary apartment) and in-law suite,
2. Schedule B (Classification Table) to ensure secondary suite and in-law suite are listed as examples for the single dwelling class,
3. Schedule C for the RMD, RI, RLL, RSL, MIX, TC and CMS Land Use Zone Tables to add secondary suite and in-law suite to the list of permitted uses and specify conditions, and
4. Schedule D (Off-street Parking Requirements) to exchange the term subsidiary apartment with secondary suite and in-law suite conditions.

The proposed text amendment will amend the term “subsidiary apartment” to be titled “secondary suite” in the Development Regulations and associated Schedules.

The purpose of the amendment is to accelerate the permitting of “missing middle” dwelling units, so the Town can consider secondary suites and in-law suites as permitted uses within single dwellings in all residential land use zones, as well as within existing single dwellings within the Mixed Development (MIX), Town Centre (TC) Zone and Commercial Main Street (CM) Zones.

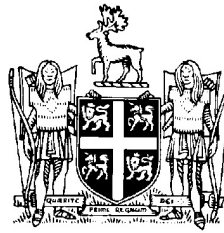
