Food - Routine Inspection Oct 16, 2025	Critical Item(s)	404 - Toxic Chemicals Properly Labeled, Stored and Used to Prevent Food Contam.	Corrected During Inspection Ensure all chemical spray bottles are properly labeled.
	Non-Critical Item(s)	704 - Adequate protection from vermin and insect pests	Continue with control measures to prevent fruit flies, especially behind bar and dish pit.
Food - Annual Inspection Mar 17, 2025	Non-Critical Item(s)	606 - Adequate mechanical ventilation	The vent hood requires cleaning.
Food - Routine Inspection Jan 26, 2024	Critical Item(s)	104 - Proper Cooling Time and Temperatures	Improper cooling of gravy observed. Put gravy in shallow metal pans (3 inch) to facilitate rapid cooling.
		401 - Food Separated and Protected	Store ready-to-eat foods above/separate from raw foods.
		402 - Food Contact Surfaces Cleaned and Sanitized	Wiping cloths are required to be stored in a sanitizing solution (i.e. 100 ppm bleach solution or 200 ppm QUATS solution).



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Food - Routine Inspection Jan 26, 2024	Non-Critical Item(s)	803 - Chemical Test Kits and/or Papers provided	Chemical test papers required to verify concentration of sanitizing solution.
