Food - Annual Inspection Feb 06, 2026	Critical Item(s)	403 - Facility Free of Pests (Vermin and Insects)	Corrected During Inspection Evidence of pest activity was noted beneath the front-end counters. All dry goods were removed, and the affected areas were thoroughly cleaned and sanitized. Additional signs of activity were found behind the toe kicks under the counters, these areas must also be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized. Continued monitoring for any new pest activity is necessary. Exterior doors are not kept open - back doors are opened solely for deliveries and waste removal. A pest control service is actively working on site, with multiple traps in place. Two mice have been captured since February 4th, and pest control measures will continue. Management reported being aware of the pest activity and provided evidence that actions have been taken to address the issue.
