TOWN OF BISHOP'S FALLS MUNICIPAL PLAN AMENDMENT NO. 10, 2002 AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT NO. 12, 2002

Take notice that the Town of Bishop's Falls Municipal Plan Amendment No.10, 2002 and Development Regulations Amendment No. 12, 2002 adopted on the 14th day of May, 2002, and approved on the 11th day of June 2002, have been registered by the Minister of Municipal and Provincial Affairs.

In general terms the purpose of Municipal Plan Amendment No. 10 is to permit the expansion of Proweld Industries Limited (machinery and heavy equipment repair and fabrication) on the Botwood Highway, while the purpose of Development Regulations Amendment No. 12 is to implement the Municipal Plan Amendment.

The Bishop's Falls Municipal Plan Amendment No.10, 2002 and the Development Regulations Amendment No. 12, 2002 come into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette*. NOTICE OF REGISTRATION

ST. JOHN'S DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT NUMBER 256, 2002

Take notice that the City of St. John's Development Regualtions Amendment Number 256, 2002 adopted by the St. John's Municipal Council on the 17th day of June 2002, has been registered by the Minister of Municipal and Provincial Affairs.

In general terms the purpose of St. John's Development Regulations Amendment Number 256, 2002, is to establish a standard minimum side yard setback of 1.2 metres for end unit townhouse dwellings in the following land use zones:

- Residential Medium Density (R2) Zone
- Residential High Density (R3) Zone
- Residential Downtown (RD) Zone
- Residential Mixed (RM) Zone
- Apartment Special (AA) Zone
- Apartment Low Density (A1) Zone
- Apartment Medium Density (A2) Zone

The St. John's Development Regulations Amendment Number 256, 2002, comes into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette*. HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ACT, 1990

TOWN OF
GRAND FALLS-WINDSOR

Amendment #4

Repeal and Substitute Traffic Regulations No. 18

18 (a) The Town of Grand Falls Windsor is hereby authorized to determine and designate these streets in the Town of Grand Falls-Windsor which shall be used by commercial motor vehicles.

(b) All tractor trailers shall be operated only ever and along the routes herein designated in Schedule 1, attached hereto and forming part of the Regulation.

(c) This Regulation shall not prohibit:

- i. The operation of commercial motor vehicles upon any street where necessary to the conduct of business at a destination point, provided that streets upon which such traffic is permitted are used until reaching the intersection nearest the destination point.
- ii. The operations of emergency vehicles upon any street in the Town.
- iii. The operation of commercial motor vehicles owned by or operated by the Town, Public Utilities or any contractor engaged in the repair, delivery of materials, maintenance or construction of streets, street improvements, or street utilities within the Town of Grand Falls-Windsor.
- iv. The operation of commercial motor vehicles upon any officially established detour in the Town of Grand Falls-Windsor.

(d) No person shall park any commercial motor vehicle in any residential zone in the Town of Grand Falls-Windsor unless a permit for the parking has been issued by the Council.

(e) An application for a permit to park any commercial motor vehicle in any residential zone shall be made to the Council and every applicant for a permit shall finish with the application such information as Council may require.

(f) The Council shall attach to the permit such conditions as it deems fit for the parking of any commercial motor vehicle in a residential zone and may permit parking for such limited time as it deems fit.




