TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME,

GREETING;

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS under the authority of section 57 of the "*Elections Act, 1991*" (the "Act"), and pursuant to section 54 of the "*House of Assembly Act*", upon the occurrence of a vacancy by the resignation of the sitting member on the 1st day of June, 2005, we are directed to issue a Writ of Election for the election of a Member to the House of Assembly;

AND WHEREAS it is Our will and pleasure that a Writ of Election be issued for the Election of One Member to serve in the House of Assembly of Our Province of Newfoundland and Labrador for the Electoral District of Exploits;

NOW KNOW YE that We do by this Our Proclamation direct that a Writ of Election for the District of Exploits be issued;

AND WE DO further direct

1. That the date set to be the last day for nomination of candidates for the Election is Monday, the 13th day of June, 2005;
2. That the place for the nomination of candidates is 250 Water Street (adjacent to Bank of Montreal), Botwood;
3. That the day of polling for the Election is Thursday, the 23rd day of June, 2005; and,

4. That the Writ of Election shall be issued on Wednesday, the 1st day of June, 2005 and be returnable at the time and in the manner prescribed by Division E of the Act, together with the return of the person to whom the writ is directed endorsed thereon, and all other documents and other things required to be transmitted to the Chief Electoral Officer by virtue thereof.
