

Short title

1. These regulations may be cited as the *Labrador Border Zones Rebate Regulations, 2006*.

Rebate amount

2. The rebate of tax in Labrador border zones established under section 9 of the *Tobacco Tax Act* for tobacco shall be

- (a) for cigarettes, \$0.0975 per cigarette; and
- (b) for tobacco, \$0.2136 per gram.

Transitional

3. Notwithstanding section 2, where a dealer submitted a rebate on or before March 30, 2006, that rebate shall be processed at the rate in effect on the date the cigarettes or tobacco subject to the rebate were purchased.

Repeal

4. The *Labrador Border Zones Rebate Regulations, 2004*, Newfoundland and Labrador Regulation 63/04, are repealed.

Commencement

5. These regulations shall be considered to have come into force on March 31, 2006.
