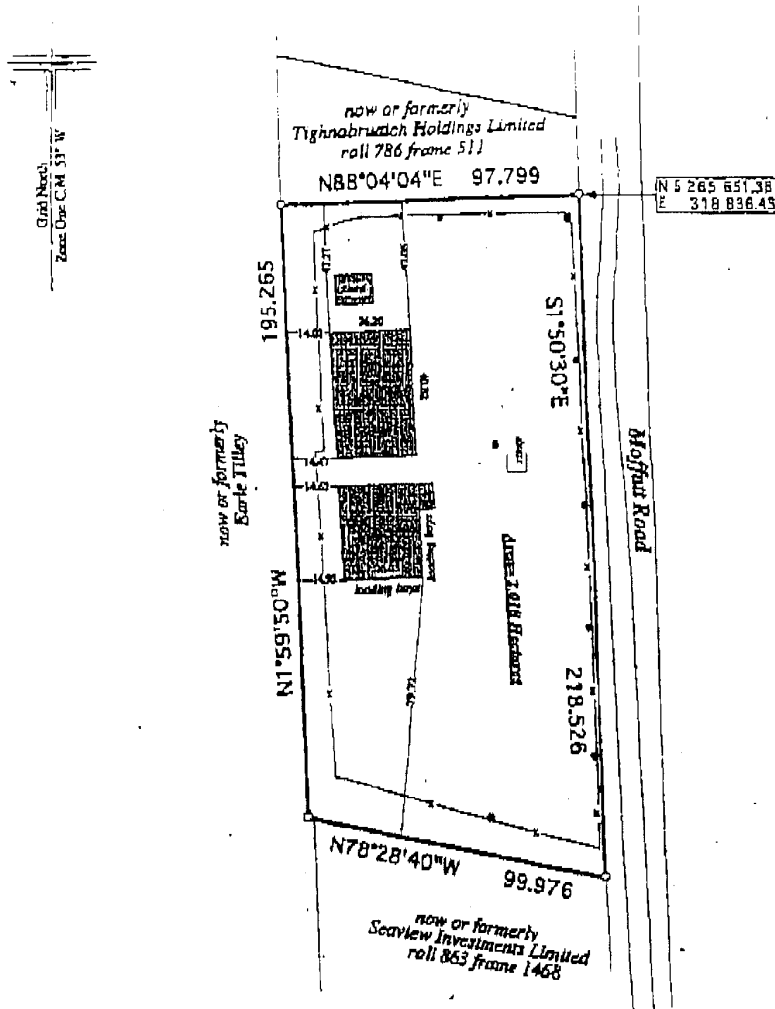

1. Section 30 of the *Lottery Licensing Regulations* is repealed and the following substituted:

Prizes

30. (1) An organization licensed under section 3 may offer alcohol as a prize in a licensed lottery event to persons over the age of 19 years.

(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), the *Liquor Control Act* precludes the granting of alcohol as prizes to any person under the age of 19 years.

(3) It is an offence under the *Tobacco Control Act* to give tobacco as a prize to a person under the age of 19 years.

(4) A prize of a firearm shall not be given to a person who is not authorized under the *Firearms Act* (Canada) to possess a firearm.
