In general terms, the purpose of the Municipal Plan Amendment No. 14 - 2008 is to re-designate three parcels of property in the Elizabeth Park residential subdivision from their respective designations of “Public Use”, “Conservation” and “Open Space Buffer” to “Residential”. Development Regulations Amendment No. 34 -2008 re-zones the same lands from their respective designations to “Residential Medium Density”.

The amendments come into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette*.
