URBAN AND RURAL PLANNING ACT

NOTICE OF REGISTRATION TOWN OF TWILLINGATE MUNICIPAL PLAN AMENDMENT NO. 2, 2010 AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT NO. 2, 2010

Take notice that the TOWN OF TWILLINGATE Municipal Plan Amendment No. 2, 2010 and Development Regulations Amendment No. 2, 2010 as adopted on the 12th day of April, 2010 and approved on the 10th day of May, 2010, have been registered by the Minister of Municipal Affairs.

In general terms, the purpose of the Municipal Plan amendment and the Development Regulations amendment is to accommodate residential development along Bayview Road (Moses Marsh) by extending the Residential designation in a southerly direction to where Bayview Road intersects the Protected Watershed area. This entails redesignating and rezoning the area in question from Rural to Residential.

The Municipal Plan Amendment No. 2, 2010 and Development Regulations Amendment No. 2, 2010 come into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette*.

1. Subsection 5(3) of the *Pharmacy Regulations* is repealed and the following substituted:

(3) In order to receive a certificate of registration, a person who has not been engaged in the practice of pharmacy at least 420 hours in two consecutive calendar years shall be required to complete a course of studies or a period of internship as required by the board.

2. (1) Subsection 13(11) of the regulations is repealed and the following substituted:

(11) A pharmacist shall not fill a prescription beyond one year from the date on which the prescription was originally written, except in the circumstances outlined in the Standard of Pharmacy Practice for Medication Management adopted by the board.

(2) Section 13 of the regulations is amended by adding immediately after subsection (11) the following:

(11.1) A pharmacist shall not fill a prescription other than as directed in the prescription, except in the circumstances outlined in the Standard of Pharmacy Practice for Medication Management as adopted by the board.

(3) Subsection 13(12) of the regulations is repealed and the following substituted:

(12) Each pharmacy shall ensure that every original prescription is retained on file for 2 years from the date the prescription was filled or last refilled.
