RE: Electrical Permit Applications – Private Sewage Disposal Approvals

Electrical permit applications for “cabin areas” or “Local Service Districts (LSDs)” and any areas with potential private sewage disposal issues will cause a delay in the processing of electrical permit applications.

Service NL will require verification that a Certificate of Approval (CofA) has been provided to a property owner as per the Provincial “*Sanitation Regulations* under the *Health and Community Services Act*”. If Service NL records verify that a CofA for a property is already in place then the electrical permit request will be processed immediately.

The *Electrical Regulations* under the *Public Safety Act* state “*the chief inspector may refuse to issue an electrical permit for, or authorize a connection to, a premises until the requirements of any other legislation relative to that premises have been satisfied*”.
