

Inshore Shrimp Fishery – Spring Price 2013

The Standing Fish Price Setting Panel, hereinafter referred to as “the Panel” issued its Schedule of Hearings for 2013 on March 5th, 2013. Pursuant to Section 19 of the *Fishing Industry Collective Bargaining Act* hereinafter referred to as “the Act”, the Panel set Thursday, April 18th, 2013, as the date by which collective agreement(s) binding on all processors in the province that process shrimp must be in effect.


In the absence of such agreements, the Panel held a hearing at Thursday, May 2nd, 2013. The Parties appearing before the Panel at that time were the Fish, Food and Allied Workers, hereinafter referred to as “FFAW” and the Association of Seafood Producers.

Following the filing of written submission previously exchanged between the parties, and hearing the supporting argument and rebuttal of both parties, it is the decision of the Panel to select the position of the FFAW on price and conditions of sale for the 2013 Spring Shrimp Fishery. (Appendix A)

Section 19.11(1) of the Fishing Industry Collective Bargaining Act provides that the decision of the Panel must be in accordance with one of the positions on price and conditions of sale submitted to the Panel by the parties.

By virtue of the Act, this spring price table is binding on all processors that process the species shrimp in the Province and will form a collective agreement or part of a collective agreement with the FFAW.
