TO: FEE-FOR-SERVICE FAMILY PHYSICIANS

**RE: CONFIRMATION OF GRAND FALLS-WINDSOR AND JUNE HOLIDAYS
FOR FEE CODE 139**

Fee Code 139 was introduced to recognize Family Physicians who open their offices for regularly scheduled clinics on weekday evenings, weekends, and Holidays and thus relieve demands placed on hospital emergency departments. When a Family Physician holds a clinic on a day when a Holiday is observed and that date differs from the legal date, fee code 139 can be claimed in addition to the applicable office fee codes on the observed date.

The table below lists the dates which are considered Holidays for the purpose of claiming fee code 139.

The following rules apply with respect to claiming fee code 139:

- Fee code 139 can be billed by Family Physicians who see patients in regular scheduled clinics between the hours of 6 p.m. and midnight on weekdays, weekends, or **observed** Holidays.
- Family Physicians who practice outside St. John's & Grand Falls-Windsor may only bill fee code 139 for patients seen in regular scheduled clinics between the hours of 6 p.m. and midnight on July 21, 2025 and July 30, 2025. Start time for the patient encounter must be entered on the record of service.
- It can only be billed in addition to Family Medicine fee codes 101, 111, 112, 114, 118, 121, 122, 123, 124, 126, 127, 131, 132, 136.
- Fee code 139 is **not payable** when special visit codes 50, 52 or 53 are claimed.
- To document this code for services rendered, the start time for the patient encounter must be entered on the record of service. For weekends and Holidays, the date of service is sufficient.
