TO: CATEGORY A EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT PHYSICIANS
**RE: 2023-2027 MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT – IMPLEMENTATION OF
CATEGORY A EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT CHANGES**

The Department of Health and Community Services (HCS) and the Newfoundland and Labrador Medical Association (NLMA) have signed a new Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) effective from October 1, 2023, to September 30, 2027. The 2023-2027 MOA introduces shift premiums for Category A Emergency Department services as per Article 16.06. Refer to Table 1 and Table 2 below for Category A fee code billing information.

Please be advised that the submission of shift premiums must be billed to MCP as separate claims.

Note: Both the Health Sciences Centre and St. Clare's Mercy Hospital are excluded as those sites are covered under an Alternate Payment Plan.

Additional changes to the MOA, as per Article 16.06, for the attention of Category A Emergency Department physicians include the following (note that PHA refers to Provincial Health Authority):

16.06 (c) “Each physician providing Category A emergency services will be provided with a contract by the PHA which will reference the terms of this Agreement and may include other related requirements of NLHS in respect of the Category A emergency services.”

16.06 (d) “Each physician providing Category A emergency services will participate in a posted schedule for the provision of services, the process for which will be managed by PHA on a pre-determined basis (e.g., quarterly). Each physician is expected to advise PHA regarding their preferred volume of service and preferred dates when the schedule is being developed, and a

final schedule will be by mutual agreement. Once a schedule is determined, the schedule will not be changed unless there is either mutual agreement between PHA and the physician, or there are extenuating circumstances (e.g., illness; bereavement)."

16.06 (e) "PHA will provide to the NLMA, on an annual basis, a list of physicians, by facility, who have contracts to provide Category A emergency services."

Physicians should consult with their site leadership regarding the above MOA items. For clarity regarding MOA Article 16.06(d) it is to be understood that once established the schedule stands and, with the exception of extenuating circumstances as referenced, shift coverage is the physician's responsibility as per the requirements of the MOA.
