

Change to an Existing Drug on the Newfoundland and Labrador Prescription Drug Program Benefit List (Not Price Increase Related)

A manufacturer may request a change to an existing Newfoundland and Labrador Prescription Drug Program (NLPDP) product listing in the following circumstances:

- Change in ownership
- Package size/format change
- Drug Identification Number (DIN) update
- Formulation change
- Price decrease

In order to request a change as outlined above, a manufacturer must:

- Inform the NLPDP of the changes in electronic format;
- Address the notification only to nlpdp_bpo@bell.ca;
- Note 'Manufacturer Change' in the subject line of the email;
- Provide a statement to summarize the change(s) and attach the following information in an Excel spreadsheet:
 - Medication name, strength, dosage form, and DIN
 - Current package size
 - Current manufacturer
 - New medication name and DIN, if applicable
 - New package size, if applicable
 - New manufacturer, if applicable
 - Details regarding change in formulation, if applicable
 - Decreased price, if applicable*
 - Effective date of the change
