Re: Canada Community Building Fund (CCBF)

I am pleased to provide the updated application and guidelines for the Canada Community-Building Fund (CCBF).

Infrastructure investments are foundational to building strong, inclusive, and sustainable communities. CCBF provides municipalities across Newfoundland and Labrador with the opportunity to advance projects that address immediate local needs, while also supporting long-term priorities such as housing availability and community resilience.

As part of our commitment to improving infrastructure tracking and planning, a new reporting requirement has been introduced. Infrastructure projects funded through the CCBF must now include geolocation data, specifically single point location coordinates (latitude and longitude) for physical assets such as buildings, roads and utilities. A supporting guide is also attached to help you in meeting this requirement.

Unspent CCBF allocations by municipalities are missed opportunities to enhance local infrastructure, stimulate economic development, and address pressing community needs. Municipalities are strongly encouraged to fully use their CCBF funding to help build vibrant, inclusive communities across Newfoundland and Labrador.
