BACKGROUND

The Town of Deer Lake has received a request to amend its Municipal Plan to allow the development of a storage unit rental facility on Hillside Drive. The proposed amendment will change the Future Land Use designation of approximately 0.5 hectares located on the east side of Hillside Drive from Rural to Commercial-Industrial.

PUBLIC CONSULTATION

Public notice of the proposed amendment was posted on July 24, 2024, as follows:

- Town of Deer Lake website
- Town of Deer Lake Facebook page
- Bulletin boards at the Town Hall and Deer Lake Post Office

The notice provided a period up to August 5, 2024, for the submission of written objections or other comments. No submissions were received.
