TAKE NOTICE that the TOWN OF PORT REXTON MUNICIPAL PLAN and DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENTS NO. 2, 2024, adopted on the 11th day of June, 2025, and approved on the 9th day of July 2025, have been registered by the Minister of Municipal and Provincial Affairs.

THE MUNICIPAL PLAN AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS amendments make a number of policy and regulatory changes that will enable new housing units to be constructed throughout Port Rexton by:

- Allowing accessory dwelling units to be constructed on existing residential lots in the form of garden suites and subsidiary apartments,
- Accommodating ancillary residential units such as worker's accommodation or supportive housing in the Commercial and Community Service land use designation and zone, and
- Recognizing modular housing as an acceptable form of construction.

The amendments add to the Municipal Plan, goals, objectives and policies that incorporate the principles of physical literacy into decision-making concerning the development of public recreation lands and facilities in the Town. The corresponding amendment to the Development Regulations requires that recreational open space and facilities be designed and constructed to support physical literacy.
