TAKE NOTICE that the TOWN OF PARADISE DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT NO. 30, 2025, adopted on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of September, 2025, has been registered by the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Community Engagement.

This amendment re-zones lands at 1641-7 Topsail Road from Commercial General (CG) to Planned

Mixed Development Commercial (PMDC). The purpose is to enable flexible development standards, aligned with the zoning of the neighbouring parcel, and to facilitate a planned public road access in support of the overall comprehensive development plans for the area.

TAKE NOTICE that the TOWN OF PORT REXTON MUNICIPAL PLAN AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENTS NO. 3, 2025, adopted on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2025, and approved on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2025, have been registered by the Minister of Municipal and Provincial Affairs.

The amendments add to the Municipal Plan, goals, objectives and policies that incorporate the principles of physical literacy into decision-making concerning the development of public recreation lands and facilities in the Town. The corresponding amendment to the Development Regulations requires that recreational open space and facilities be designed and constructed to support physical literacy.
