

Chapter 9: Special Needs Benefits

(xiii) Back to School Benefit

Intent:	To outline eligibility criteria for the Back to School Benefit for families currently in receipt of income support with school-aged dependents.
Act: (if applicable)	N/A
Regulations:	<p>19. (5) Other income support for which an applicant or recipient may be eligible is:</p> <p>(e) for a recipient with one or more school-aged dependents, an annual contribution towards school-related expenses in the amount of \$100 a year in respect of each school-aged dependent of the recipient; and</p> <p>(f) for a recipient who is 18 years of age or older but under 21 years of age who attends high school, an annual contribution towards school-related expenses in the amount of \$100 a year.</p>
Overview: (if applicable)	<p>The Back to School Benefit is designed to support families receiving income support by helping cover the cost of school supplies for school-aged dependents at the start of each academic year.</p> <p>The benefit will be automatically issued to eligible families once per year, during the months of August or September, for the upcoming school year.</p>
Policy:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Families who receive Income Support benefits in August and/or September with school-aged dependents active on their file are eligible. Recipients aged 18 to 21 who are still completing their high school education are also eligible, provided they submit verification of enrollment for the upcoming school year. The benefit provides \$100 per eligible dependent/recipient.

Procedure:	Client Services Officers must:
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Confirm the number of school aged dependents active on the family's file.• Receive verification of enrollment from recipients aged 18 to 21 who are still completing their high school education before providing the benefit.• Issue the benefit once per year, during the months of August or September, for the upcoming school year.
