


# NEWFOUNDLAND & LABRADOR OVERALL

## 2024 REGISTERED ACCOMMODATIONS OCCUPANCY UPDATE

- The accommodations sector continued to perform well relative to 2019 through 2024, however, preliminary data show a slowdown compared to 2023\*
- In 2024, registered accommodations in the province reported **1.6 million room nights sold**, a decrease of 6% from 2023 but 17% above the same period in 2019
- **Accommodation occupancy reached 53%** in 2024, a decrease of 4 percentage points compared to 2023 but 7 points higher than in 2019
- **Total provincial room revenue reached \$274 million** in 2024, up 1% from 2023 and still 42% above 2019
- The **ADR reached \$169** in 2024, up 7% from 2023 (\$158), and up 22% from where it stood during 2019 (\$138)




\*Note: In 2023, a significant room supply was allocated for alternate use (social housing needs; temporary shelter for new Canadians), impacting year-over-year comparison to 2023 particularly in the St. John's area.

# LABRADOR

## 2024


- In 2024, there were **294,764 room-nights available** in the Labrador region
- Registered accommodations in Labrador reported **192,389 room nights sold**, a decrease of 3% from 2023 but 36% above 2019
- **Accommodation occupancy in Labrador reached 65.3%** in 2024, on par with the same period of 2023 and 19 points higher than in 2019
- **Total room revenue in Labrador reached \$30.9 million** in 2024, up 7% from 2023, and 64% above 2019
- The **ADR reached \$161** in 2024, up 11% from 2023 (\$145), and up 21% from where it stood in 2019 (\$133)



# WESTERN REGION

2024


- In 2024, there were **665,921 room-nights available** in the Western region
- Registered accommodations in the Western region reported **316,416 room nights sold**, a decrease of 3% from 2023 but 14% above 2019
- **Accommodation occupancy in the Western region reached 47.5%** in 2024, on par with 2023 but still 8 points higher than this period of 2019
- **Total room revenue in the Western region reached \$49.4 million** in 2024, up 3% from 2023 and 33% above 2019
- The **ADR in the region reached \$156** in 2024, up 6% from 2023 (\$148), and up 17% from where it stood in 2019 (\$134)



# CENTRAL REGION

2024


- In 2024, there were **489,702 room-nights available** in the Central region
- Registered accommodations in the Central region reported **215,143 room nights sold**, a slight increase of 2% from 2023 and 12% higher than in 2019
- **Accommodation occupancy in Central** reached **43.1%** in 2024, a decrease of 4 points compared to 2023 and on par with 2019 (43%).
- **Total room revenue in the Central region** reached **\$42.5 million** in 2024, up 5% from 2023 and 33% above 2019
- The **ADR in the region** reached **\$197** in 2024, up 3% from 2023 (\$191), and up 19% from where it stood in 2019 (\$166)



# EASTERN REGION

2024

- In 2024, there were **268,388 room-nights available** in the Eastern region
- Registered accommodations in the Eastern region reported **111,226 room nights sold**, a decrease of 5% from 2023 but 16% above 2019
- **Accommodation occupancy in the Eastern region reached 41.4%** in 2024, a decrease of 4 points compared to 2023 but still 5 points higher than in 2019
- **Total room revenue in the Eastern region reached \$18.0 million** in 2024, up 1% from 2023 but still 34% above 2019
- The **Eastern region ADR reached \$162** in 2024, up 7% from 2023 (\$151), and up 15% from where it stood in 2019 (\$140)



# AVALON REGION

2024

- In 2024, there were **1.33 million room-nights available** in the Avalon region
- Registered accommodations in the Avalon region reported **792,339 room nights sold**, a decrease of 8% from 2023 but 17% above 2019
- **Accommodation occupancy on the Avalon reached 59.5%** in 2024, a decrease of 7 points compared to 2023 but still 7 points higher than in 2019.
- **Total room revenue in the region reached \$133.6 million** in 2024, down 2% from 2023, but still 49% above the same period in 2019
- The **ADR reached \$169** on the Avalon in 2024, up 7% from 2023 (\$158), and up 27% from where it stood during the same period of 2019 (\$133)
