

2027 Canada Winter Games Chef Team Application Team Newfoundland and Labrador

Team NL is currently looking to fill the role of the Chef Team for the 2027 Canada Winter Games taking place in Québec City from February 26 – March 15, 2027.

The Chef Team is comprised of a Chef de Mission along with two Assistant Chef de Missions. The Chef team works closely with Sport NL to prepare Team NL for participation at the Games. Below is a description of each position:

Chef de Mission

The Chef de Mission is the team leader for the province/territory and, in consultation with the Canada Games Council and the Host Society, coordinates the overall participation of Team NL during the Canada Games. The Chef ensures that all requirements are completed in a manner which upholds the spirit and philosophy of the Canada Games movement.

Assistant Chef(s) de Mission (Two positions)

The two Assistant Chef de Missions are second-in-command for Team NL and in the absence of the Chef, acts as its designate. In addition to providing general support to the Chef, the Assistant Chef usually holds primary responsibility for specified components of operational requirements of the provincial contingent.
