1. The setting.

NARRATOR

And the story of one? Is our story today...

2. Protagonist I

In a cramped, dark apartment sits a sad zombie named LIL (30).

NARRATOR

She was known as Lil-a-Lee
A zombie with a Ph.D.
An expert on historic Wales
Is why she worked in retail sales.

3. Protagonist II

Playing 3rd base in a pro (minor league) baseball game is a zombie named WILL (30).

NARRATOR

He was known as Will E. Smirk
A handsome zombie, out of work.
He played pro baseball (Single A)
But threw his arm to make a play.

4. Antagonist

Watching the ballgame from near 1st base is a teenager named BEA who has been screaming abusive, anti-zombie sentiments at Will since the first pitch. Will has just missed an easy pop-fly due to her vitriol.

NARRATOR

Will grabbed the ball, threw hard compared
To what no zombo ever dared!
Hard enough for out at 1st!
Yet far too hard. His elbow burst.
