MARSHALING YARDS & TEMPORARY WORK CAMPS

Equipment or material storage yards and temporary work camps shall be located at least 100 metres from any watercourse or designated wetland.

The Contractor is responsible for obtaining all appropriate permits from government agencies with legislation and regulations relevant to camp facilities. These permits include, but are not necessarily limited to, those related to: solid and liquid waste disposal, water supply, sewage treatment, development control, Crown Lands, and any Municipal Authority having jurisdiction over the area.

Any site proposed for a marshaling yard or work camp should be of low value with respect to its potential for other uses when compared to other lands in the area. Abandoned gravel pits, abandoned commercial enterprises, or other previously disturbed areas are preferred locations. Any site must be located so as to minimize potential traffic hazards. Incoming and outgoing vehicles should be able to merge safely with other traffic. Prior to the commencement of construction the Contractor will submit a list of candidate sites, which will be reviewed and accepted by the Owner's Representative and any other relevant agency.
